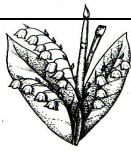

Artists Robin Colodzin and Jonathan Talbot have created an online guide to artists around the world at www.theartsmap.com

When you're traveling and want to check out the local art scene, it's easy to find museums and galleries but how about artist's studios? The two artists decided to create The Arts Map by the awareness that many talented and creative people are often invisible even in their own communities. Listings on The Arts Map are user-generated, any arts-related person or business can create a listing. Basic listings on The Arts Map are free for artists, art organizations, museums, etc. Currently The Arts Map has more than 1.900 listing in 42 countries. Plans are in the works to include adding search functions based on style and subject matter. They are also developing software that will allow users to list and search

SOS for ART

You probably have some sort of emergency plan for your home. But what about your painting and art stuff? Whether it's off-site or part of your home, your art materials and artwork need special protection before and after disaster strikes, whether it's an earthquake or just burst water pipes.

The Craft Emergency Relief Fund is a non-profit organization whose mission is to strengthen and sustain the careers of craft artists across the US. The Group helps artists recover after an emergency and to help prevent problems. It has developed a two-pronged approach. A website and information tool kit to help artists be disaster ready and disaster resilient. The organizations small measure taken in advance of an emergency and the right sequence of emergency response actions can make a huge difference in reducing loss and the time it takes to rebound from a setback.

At www.studioprotector.org artists will find a comprehensive digest of general, medium-specific, and disaster-specific, information that guides the user through all aspects of emergency management plus interviews with artists and experts. You can find everything from backing up computer files to how to clean up after a disaster to information on relief service and getting back on your feet after a disaster.
